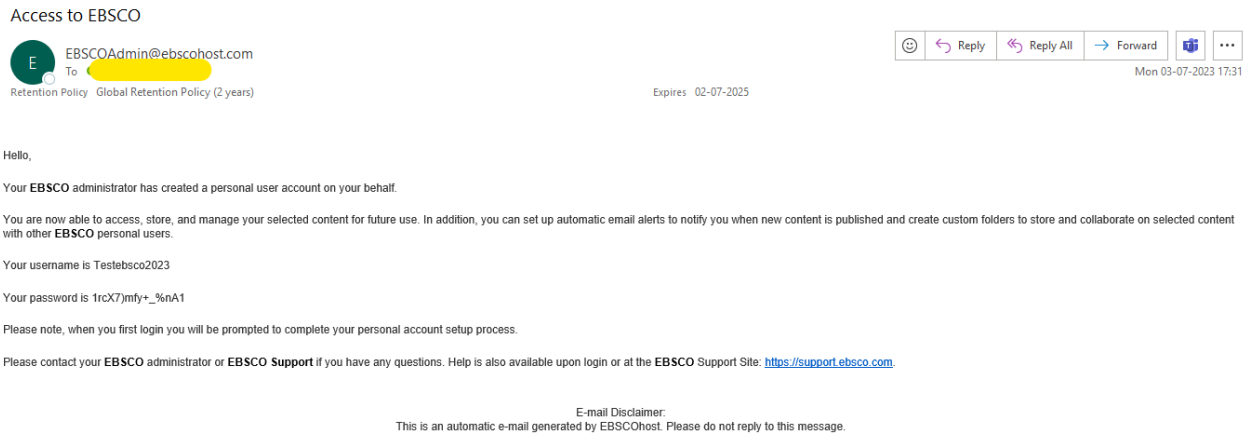


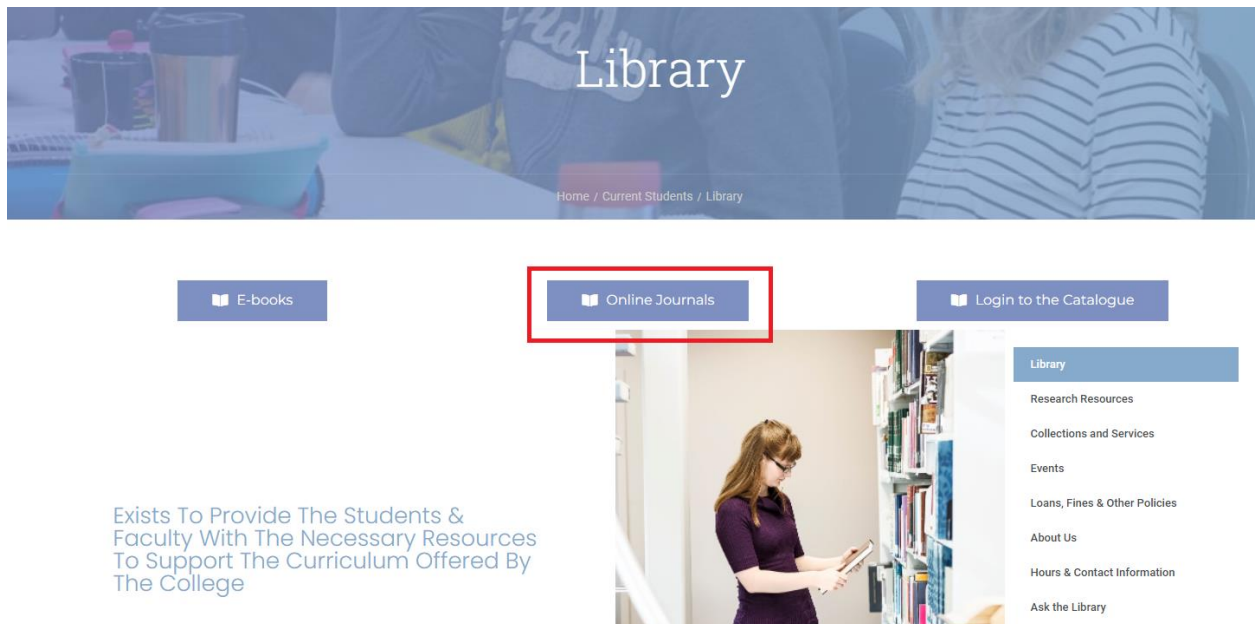
How to Create an EBSCO Account to Access Online Journals

1. An account will be created for you by your librarian, though there are still a few extra steps that you will need to go through to configure it.
2. You will receive an email that looks like this:



Take note of the password. This email indicates that your librarian has set up an account and you can proceed with the next steps.

3. Click on [this link](#) or go to the library website and click on the button that says ‘Online Journals’.



4. You should now be on a page that looks like this:

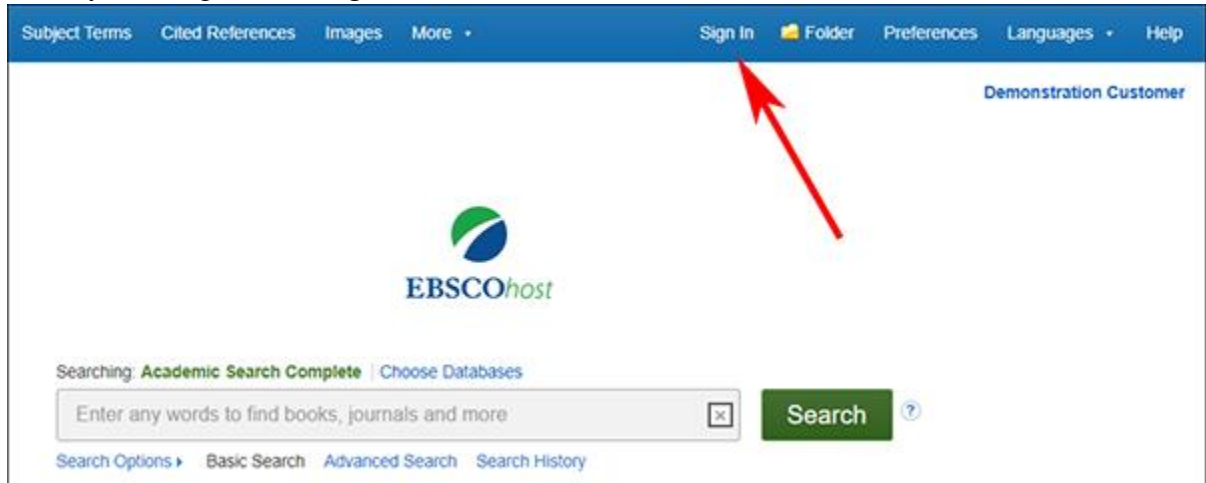

Sign in using the username and password in the email.

5. Accept the consent form.
 - a. Note: [If you do not accept the consent form](#) you WILL still have access to ABC's resources, but you will NOT have access to any of the special features like [Saving Your Searches](#) or [Creating Custom Folders](#).
6. You now have access to ABC's Online Journals! You can sign in to your account at any time by clicking on the 'Sign In' button.



7. Note: Special features (mentioned above) will not be accessible until you've logged out and logged in again.

(Optional) Update Your Password

8. In the top right corner of the screen click on 'Update My Account'



Here you can:

- a. Change your password to something more memorable than what was automatically set.
 - b. Add your name (if you want to)
9. Note: Changes will not be applied until you log out and log in again.
