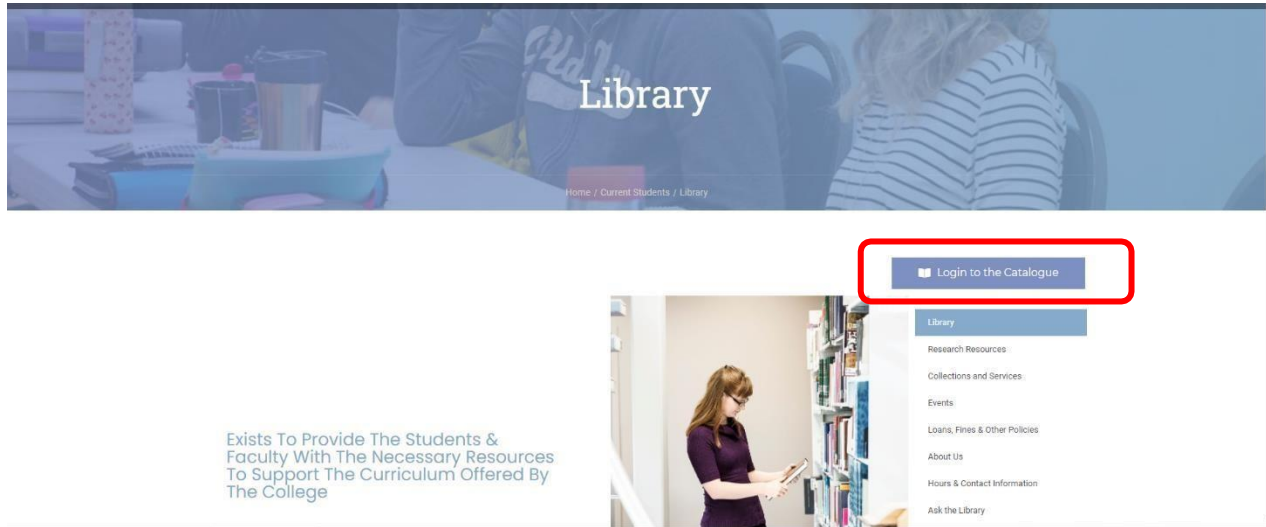
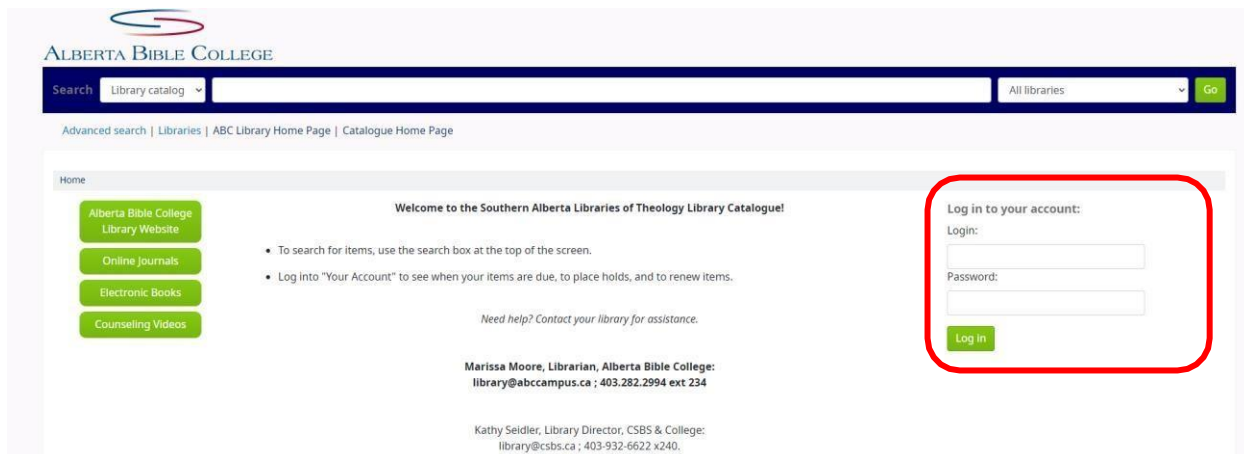


# How to Place a Hold

To start off with go to the [library page](https://www.abccampus.ca/current-students/library/) (https://www.abccampus.ca/current-students/library/). Once there, there is a box that says **Login to the Catalogue**



From here we are going to log into your account to make it easier to place holds. As seen below the login information is at the top right of the screen.



Your login information is your ABC email address and the last 4 digits of your phone number (unless you manually changed it in your account settings). If you changed it and do not remember what your password is either come to the library or email the librarian and we can reset it for you.


